Overview

NetDocuments is where law firms store their most sensitive data. Contracts, litigation evidence, M and A files, privileged communications, intellectual property, and client records all reside inside this platform.

The Blind Spot in Law Firm Security

Law firms typically monitor firewall, endpoint, and email.

They do not monitor who is accessing which documents, who is downloading entire case folders, who is changing permissions to sensitive matters, what NetDocuments administrators are doing, and early signs of insider threat or data exfiltration.

NetDocuments becomes a major security blind spot.

What Vijilan Does

Vijilan pulls NetDocuments audit and administrative activity logs every five minutes into its SIEM and SOC platform.

This provides continuous monitoring of document activity, detection of insider threats, detection of data exfiltration behavior, monitoring of NetDocuments administrator actions, and compliance evidence for audits and client questionnaires.

What Is Monitored



User Activity

Document access, document downloads, folder and workspace activity, permission changes, file deletions and moves, and unusual access patterns.



Administrative Activity

Permission modifications, workspace and folder creation, privilege abuse, and suspicious administrative behavior.

Security Use Cases

- 1 Attorney leaving the firm and downloading case files.
- 2 Paralegal accessing matters outside their practice group.
- 3 Compromised credentials harvesting documents before ransomware.
- 4 Insider copying sensitive client data.
- 5 Admin creating hidden access for specific users.

Compliance and Audit Value

Evidence for SOC 2, ISO 27001, HIPAA, GDPR, client security questionnaires, and M&A due diligence.
